8.	Fees for additional courses/increase intake for affiliation.	The matter needs to be discussed to facilitate addition of additional courses in affiliated institution. One expert member from the panel of the experts as provided by the members of the Academic Council. Every member of the Academic Council has been requested to provide two names of the experts within a week.

AICTE has notified that AICTE approved Institutions, which are running 2 nd shift will remove the 2 nd shift within two years. Within these two years they will develop their necessary infrastructure and recruit the faculties required. 11.	To Initiate PG and Ph.D. Programme in the campus from Academic Session July 2021.	The matter needs to be discussed to finalize various requirement to initiate these courses.	<p>After detailed deliberation by the members present, it was resolved with the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Five Post Graduate Specialized Inter disciplinary Courses (I.O.T., POWER ELECTRONICS, MANUFACTURING TECHNOLOGY, ENVIRONMENTAL ENGINEERING) under the different P.G. Departments of JUT shall be started from the Academic Session 2021-22. 2. 20 seats as the course intake for each said programmes shall be allocated. In which, admissions of 10 seats shall be preferably taken from Industrial Professionals and admissions of 10 seats shall be done as per the merit of the GATE Score. If any seat remain vacant then it will be filled by non GATE students. However, no scholarship will be given them. The reservation policy of the state government will be followed in the admission. 3. Under each said courses, scholarship shall be granted to 05 (five) admitted students through GATE score from the JUT internal fund till the University get the fund from MHRD/ AICTE/ other funding agency.
12.	Singing of MoU's with Institutions/University.	The matter needs to be discussed to strengthen the Academic Eco system of University & its affiliated colleges.	<p>After perusal and discussion at length by the members present it was approved, and as per proposal received for MoU's with Gandhi Smriti and Darshan Samiti, New Delhi & Sarla Birla University shall be done.</p>

Also it was suggested that an annual budget for the activities related to the University Placement Cell shall be prepared and all affiliated Colleges shall contribute financial support for the same. 2. After discussion by the members present, it was decided and approved that honorarium to the member of Syllabus Committee shall be paid Rs. 1,000/- (Rs. one thousand) for content development of each paper meeting from JUT internal Fund. 3. After discussion by the members present it was decided and approved that honorarium to the professional experts of Start-up services shall be paid Rs. 2,000/- (two thousand) per day, from JUT internal Fund. 4. After discussion by the members present it was decided and approved that honorarium to teacher/ guest faculty shall be paid Rs. 2,000/- (two thousand) per day, from JUT internal Fund. 5. After discussion by the members present it was decided and approved that honorarium to Industrial expert Professional shall be paid Rs. 2,000/- (two thousand) per day, from JUT
